

Payment/Enrollment Information

You will receive confirmation of your child's enrollment through a quarterly invoice. Students are enrolled on a "first come, first served" basis. **Please make your check or money order out to: OCS, School's Out!** Write your child's name and the current quarter on the check or envelope. Financial Assistance

Sliding Scale Fees

In order to help sustain this valuable program, quarterly fees are charged. It is also required that we provide a sliding scale fee system for our families. We have designed our fee system to align with the free/reduced lunch program criteria.

- *Quarterly fees are based on the school lunch program and charged per club for the entire quarter.*
- *Fees will not be adjusted in the event of an absence or cancellation.*
- *Families with multiple children receive a reduced rate to keep costs reasonable.*

Adding/Dropping Enrichment Clubs
